Berwick-upon-Tweed Bridge Club invites you to its thirty-eighth annual Congress to be held on Sunday 26 April 2020 at Berwick Rugby Club, Scremerston, Berwick-upon-Tweed. The venue lies off the Berwick by-pass to the south of Berwick on the northern edge of the village of Scremerston. The village is clearly signposted off the A1 and the rugby pitches and clubhouse are clearly visible to the east of the road through the village. The Congress will be a two session event. Please be at your place by 12.50pm at the latest. The afternoon session, starting at 1pm, will be an Open Pairs Championship with duplicated boards played across all sections and computerised scoring across the field.
